Introduction of organization:

SANJH Pakistan is a non-profit and non-governmental, non-political organization. SANJH Pakistan is registered with SECP from 17th November 2017. SANJH is a word of local language which means collaboration of people.

SANJH main focus is to make change human behavior. SANJH is especially rights-based organization. Since its start it activated to work for human rights. SANJH has geographical presence in District Muzaffargarh, Multan, Layyah, Jhang, Bahawalpur and Sukkhar. SANJH is mainly focusing on following thematic area: Peace promotion, Poverty alleviation, Climate change, Human Rights, Justice, Education, Health, Disaster management and disaster risk reduction (DRR).

SANJH has faith on sustainable development and fraught to bring change through participatory growth according to the local needs and atmosphere. The policy of SANJH is to work at grass root level with local communities and SANJH forms village committees for each project. SANJH uses the tool of communicating theater for advocacy and awareness. SANJH has two theater groups.

Wasaib Aman Kaths I: (2nd July 2018 to 15th March 2019) Completed

Brief Statement of Purpose/Project Summary:

Under this activity, Sanjh Pakistan intends to engage 3,000 community members to promote importance of peace in 30 villages of two union councils of Bosan Town, District Multan, by revival of local dispute resolution structures through establishing “Wasaib Amn Kaths (WAKs)”. Each 15 member WAK comprise of community members representing different backgrounds. WAKs has strengthen their work by developing and organizing 100 Community Actions engaging local community members from diverse backgrounds. WAKs served as a common place where people from all segments of society sit together on regular basis to address peace and other steps for the betterment of their communities.

Background:

The population of Bosan Town in Multan District is approximately 700,000, with 67% of it being rural. It is home to residents from all the major sects. Sanjh Pakistan believes that building local structures had helped collect a group of likeminded individuals from diverse background who could utilize these in resolving local conflicts, bringing social coherence and promoting peace in the villages of two UCs (83 & 84) of Bosan Town, Multan.

Objectives:

- Establish 30 WAKs in two Union Councils 83-Jhok Wains & 48-Ailam Pur
- To address peace related issues through positive interaction between different groups of the community.
- Increased broad-based Citizen Engagement in community decision-making.

Wasaib Aman Kaths' Activities

Sanjh team successfully engaged 14777 indirect and 472 direct beneficiaries from diverse backgrounds. Sanjh started those initiatives by mobilizing people of diverse background and from all sects at one platform and started giving them peace messages through different activities.

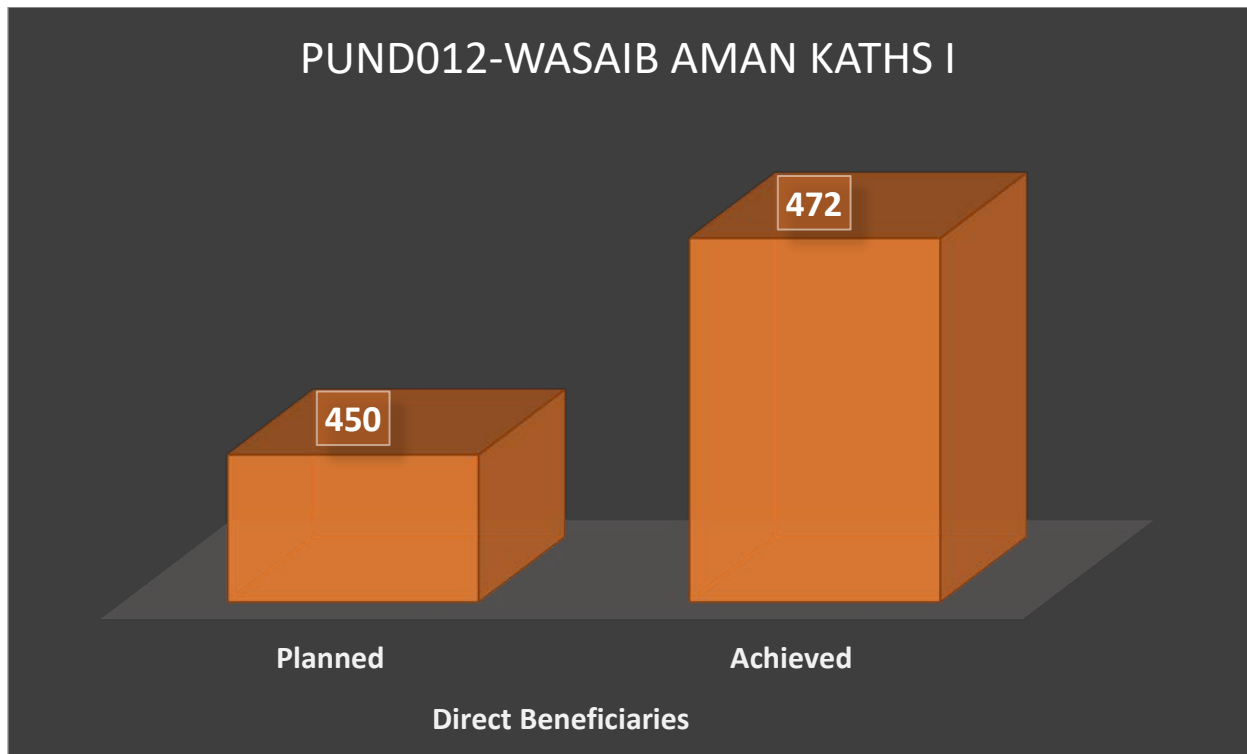
UC- Community Actions by WAK members:

WAK member organized 10 UC-community Actions with the collaboration of Sanjh Pakistan to promote peace. Those 10 UC-community actions are following:

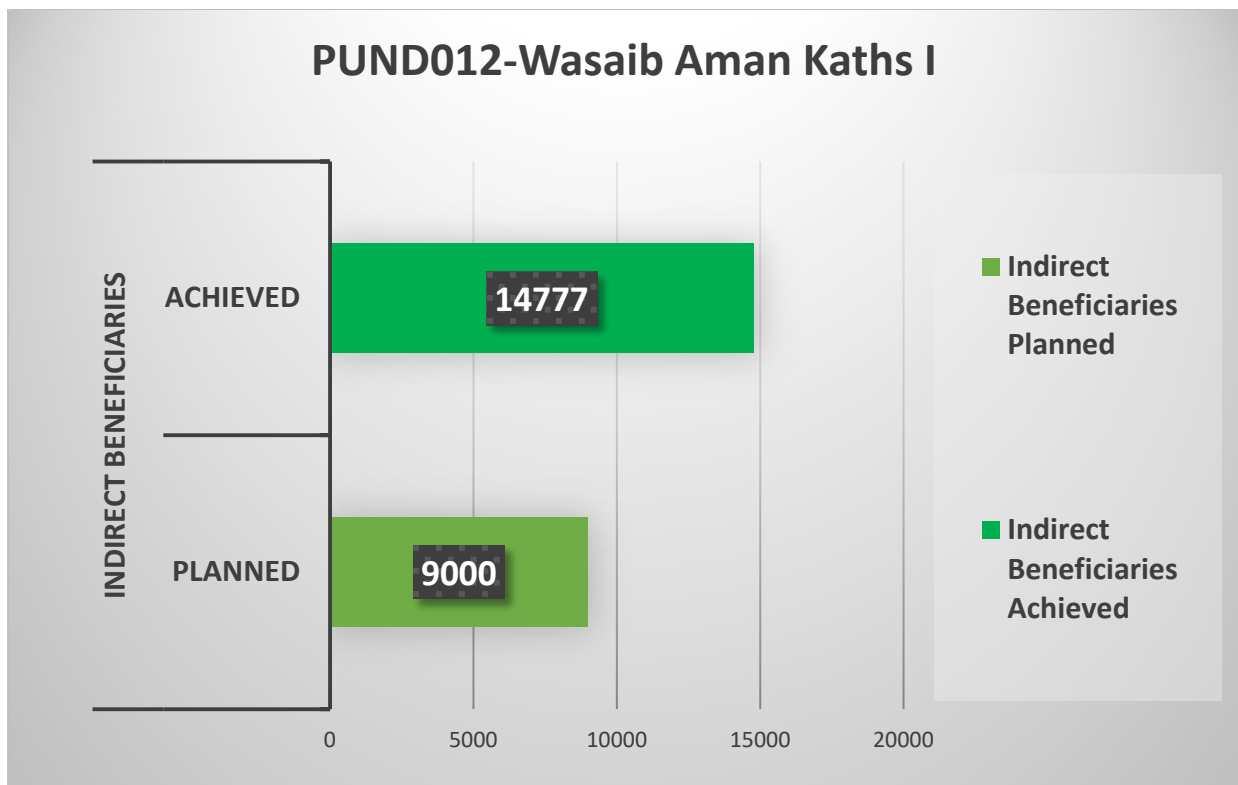

Women As peace Emissary: (19th April 2019 to 31st December 2019) Completed.

Brief Statement of Purpose/Project Summary:

This activity intends to engage female seminaries (Madaris) teachers of all religious sects and faith-based female leaders from 12 madrassas of five union councils of Bosan Town to promote peace and increase awareness about the role of women in building peaceful communities. The SANJH Pakistan had initially identify 108 female head teachers, seminary teachers and faith based women. These female teachers and faith-based female leaders along with support group members collaboratively implemented 60 Social Action Projects (SAPs) in their respective seminaries as well as communities in selected UCs on themes of peace.

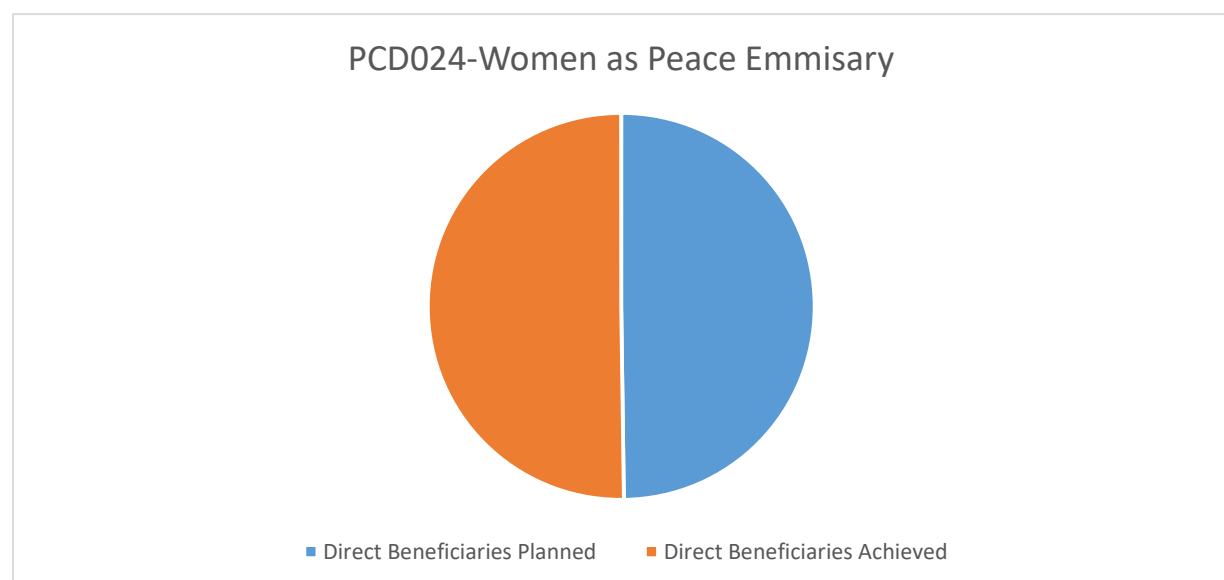
Background:

Female-only seminaries are growing force overtime, with over 200,000 females attending some 2,000 seminaries across Pakistan. Every sect in Pakistan, now, maintains girls' seminaries along with boys' with variance in curriculum implemented and activities being carried out.

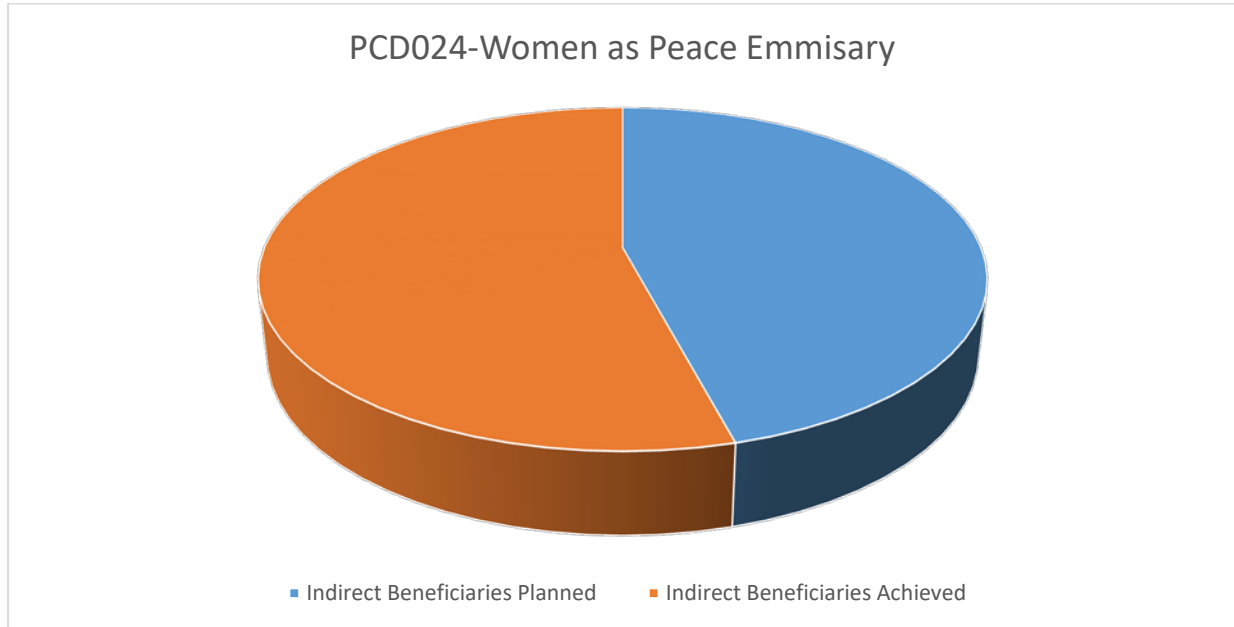

WAKs were strengthen their work by developing and organizing Social Action Projects (SAPs), budgeted and self-initiatives by engaging maximum local community members from diverse backgrounds.

- To provide advance level training for new and previously established Waseeb Aman Kath (WAK) on peace in context of roles and responsibilities in two UCs of Bosan Town.
- To increase broad-based citizen engagement in community decision-making

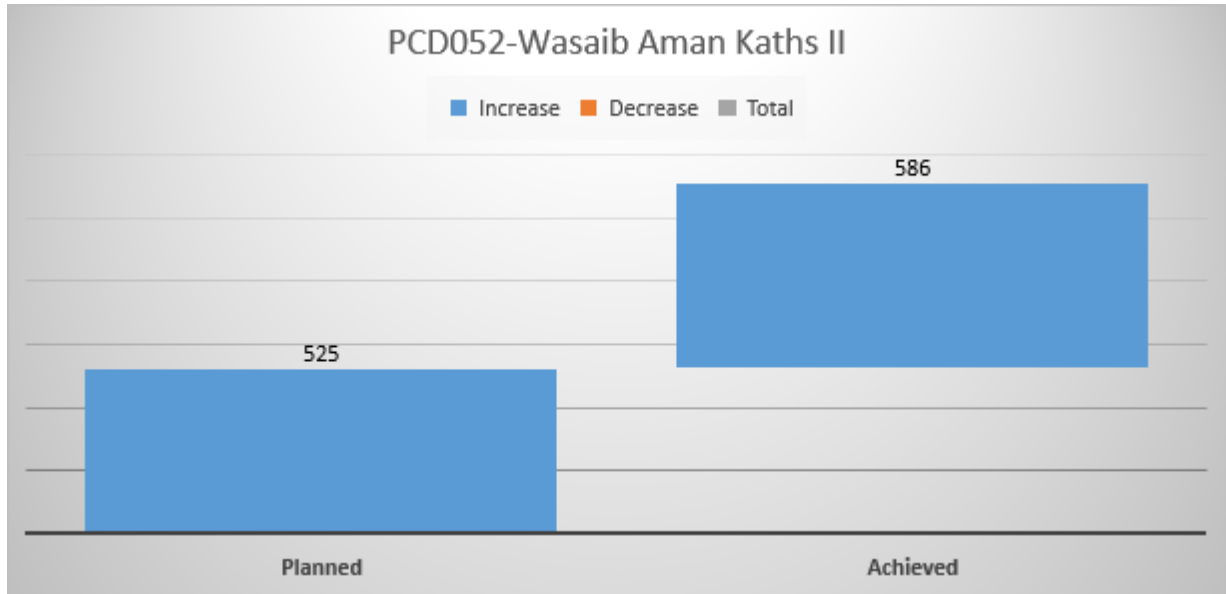

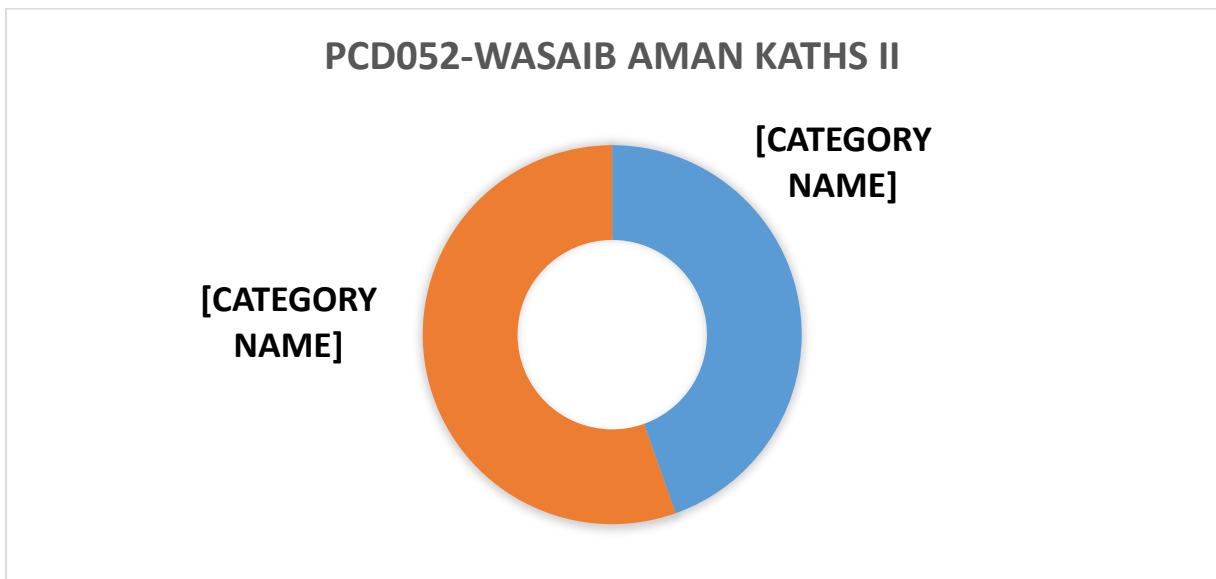

Background:

Federal and provincial governments are trying to cope with the issues related to peace. As per census 2018, women are the 52 % of total population and women have networks and access to populations and information that men do not have (especially in divided societies). - Enhanced tolerance within and across communities

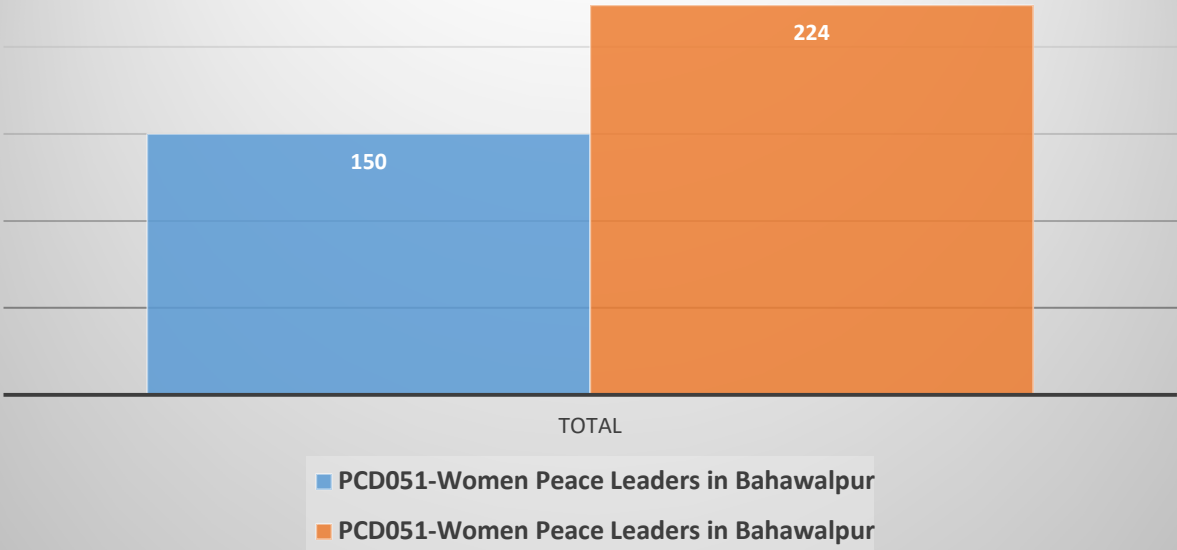

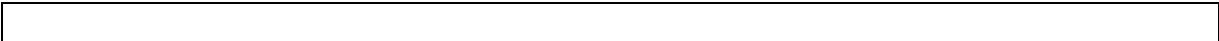

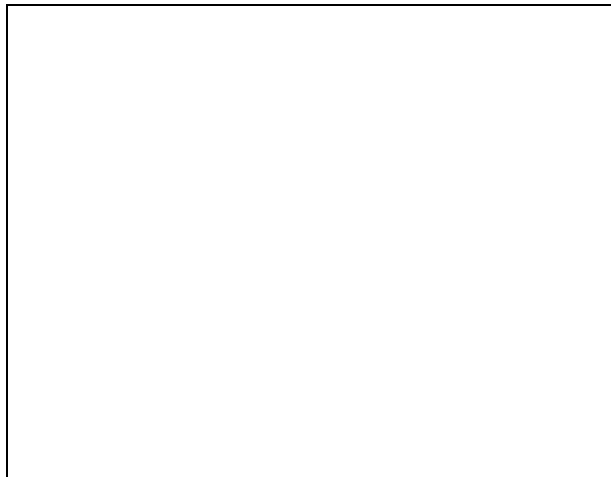

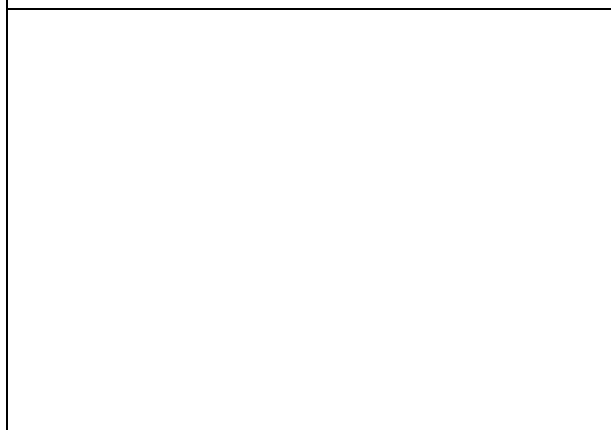
